

Felt: from 2D to 3D make a felt vessel or bowl

Using a plastic resist, repeatedly wrapped in wool, we will explore the magic of FELT; layering colours, adding texture and lustre with silk fibres, wet felting and finally transforming to a 3D structure: magic!

You need to bring:

- A towel, minimum 60 cm x 1 metre
- Bubble wrap, 50 cm x 1 metre. Small bubbles, no tears (can be two pieces 50 x 50)
- Small, pointed Scissors
- Plastic container, jug or ice cream tub

Barbara will supply: Merino wool, and silk fibres for decoration

Plastic 'resist' for forming the bowl. Net, sponge and dish soap. Tea / coffee and cake!

Barbara Weeks is passionate about Wool and the creative potential of Felt making. Her teaching and exhibiting spans 5 decades in the UK and internationally.

A journey from Quilt making to Felt making via Wool.

Now settled in Busselton, she is a member of the renown Bunbury Felting Group.
